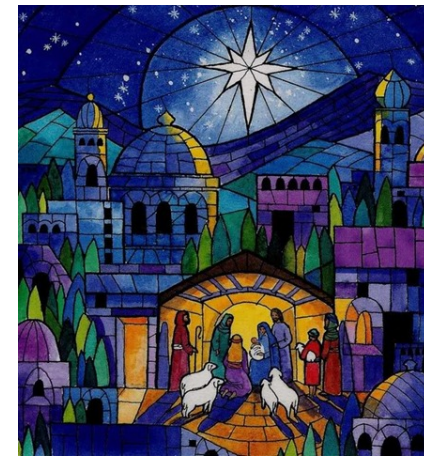

601 PASTORAL MINISTRY THESIS

This course provides the student with the opportunity to pursue, in depth, a particular topic of pastoral interest in church ministry.
