Statement from the Assumption University Board of Governors on the occasion of the passing of Rev. Joseph Quinn, CSB.

The Board of Governors of Assumption University wishes to extend its deepest condolences to Rev. Joseph Quinn, CSB's family, friends and colleagues. Father Quinn was a remarkable educator and leader who served Assumption with energy and vision. His contributions to Assumption were deep and wide-ranging. We remember with special gratitude his service as Interim President (2000-2001; 2011), his participation on the Board of Governors (1979-1982; 2001-2004) as well as his service as Chair of Assumption's Senate (2011) and its Board of Regents (2011). Father Quinn was instrumental in the founding of The Saint Basil Institute of Counselling and Mental Health Education, where he served as a counsellor and workshop leader.
